Mission statement

To improve biodiversity within Woking through practical workdays, strategic partnerships and engaging and mobilising the local community.

Objectives

1. To promote biodiversity and the importance of preserving open spaces with residents, schools, local business, contractors, building trade, conservationists and others
2. To identify areas which are particularly suitable for biodiversity enhancement and work with the Council/Landowners and local communities to improve them
3. To work with the Council/Landowners to explore cost effective ways of managing existing green spaces
4. To work with the Council on the conservation and preservation of the natural environment including future planning proposals.
5. To work with the Council on the development and implementation of the Council Biodiversity Action Plan (BAP).
